3. Please do not wait until the last minute to create your password. This will confirm that you have access to the exams when needed.
(You can create a password without activating the exam.)

WHEN IS THE X-ZONE AVAILABLE?

Multiple-choice questions are available on-line, 24 hours a day on our website, www.esp-inc.com (click on the X-Zone button below Dr. Edelman's picture).

By 8 PM on the Monday following the seminar, you will receive an email verifying that you have access to the X-Zone, which corresponds to the 12-hour classes that you attended.

WHAT DO I NEED TO GAIN ACCESS?

You must establish a password using 'Seminar Students – Set Password' on the X-Zone at www.esp-inc.com/X-Zone.aspx. We use your e-mail address that was verified at the seminar.

If an e-mail address was not provided, you must send an e-mail to zone@esp-inc.com with your name, address, and seminar attended. You will hear back from us. Then complete 'Create Your Password Now' on the X-Zone.

ARE THE QUESTIONS ON THE X-ZONE SIMILAR TO THOSE ON THE REGISTRY EXAMS?

X-Zone content is consistent with the ARDMS exam content. However, assume that the format of the questions is different. Meaningful registry prep questions challenge your knowledge of concepts. The X-Zone is a final tune-up and should confirm your command of these concepts. When you get these questions right, you're ready. Although these concepts will be tested, do not expect X-Zone questions to surface on your exam. We've said it for years – 'it is dangerous to anticipate exam questions.' Expect the unexpected. .

HOW LONG WILL I HAVE ACCESS TO THE X-ZONE?

You will have nine months after our seminar to open an X-Zone exam. Once the exam is opened, you will have six weeks of unlimited access to the subject of the class(es) that you attended.




9 Months to Activate

For example, if you attend the Physics & Abdomen courses on January 1, you may open the X-Zone until September 30th. After opening, you will have access for 6 weeks. You may open one subject at a time. For example the Abdominal X-Zone in March, but wait to activate the Physics X-Zone until May.

SAMPLE STRATEGY

1. Study the workbook multiple times without answering any of the questions in the workbook.
Make sure that you have a genuine understanding of the material in the workbook.
2. Review the quiz cards, if you have them.
3. Review the workbook again and answer the questions found within.
4. Confirm that you have command of the material. Pay special attention to the written questions that you found especially challenging.
5. Open the X-Zone and use it to assess your knowledge.
6. Review the areas of the workbook that correspond the areas of weakness from the X-Zone.
7. Continue to review you workbook and use the X-Zone.
8. Take your exam!!
